GROWTH & MAINTENANCE LEVY or BUILDING FUND DONATION

Association Membership Fee of \$20.00

Is charged annually in Term 2. This fee gives 1 nominated parent per family voting rights at the Association AGM. If both parents want this right then another \$20.00 must be paid for the other parent to be nominated.

Working Bee Fee

You have the choice of attending 1 working bee per term (there are two to choose from), or paying the \$150.00 working bee fee. The funds raised from this fee goes towards external contractor costs.

Community Job Fee

You have the choice of completing 1 community fee job per term, or paying the \$150.00 community job fee. The funds raised from the fee goes towards external contractor costs.

BISTopia Fee

The BISTopia Fee is charged each term and is \$8.20 per child to help cover the costs of Bistopia throughout the year, where each classroom buys various unusual materials and resources to be used by the students to create products for their business or service.

Omni Fee

The Omni Fee is charged Terms 1, 2 and 3 to help cover the costs of the materials used in the 5 practice Omni skill weeks prior to the Omni Presentation. The Omni fee per term will depend on the Omni Group your child is in. There are 3 levels of Omni Groups. Level 1 - \$7 (Digital Presentations, Bushcraft, Tinkerlab, Putting Things Together), Level 2 - \$15 (Presenting by Hand, Textile Craft, Sewing, Simple Machines, Art, Chemical Science Cooking Skills) and Level 3 - \$25 (Cooking).

Excursions and Incursions

During the term, class groups will participate in a variety of excursions and incursions that will incur a cost. We aim to keep the excursions within a \$55 budget per term, however it should be viewed as a yearly budget of \$220. You will be charged the actual costs on a per term basis. If one term costs is going to be well and truly higher than the \$55 budget, you will be given notice before hand.

Extra texts or tuition

Any extra textbooks or tuition required for individual children's needs will be invoiced to you if needed. These costs would be discussed with you before they are expended to ensure you are comfortable with the cost.

NAPLAN Fee

This is an Australian Government Fee and will be charged per child for those children who choose to sit NAPLAN in Grades 3 & 5. At the beginning of each year you will be given the option to opt in.

Optiminds Fee

Any Optimind competitors will be charged a fee to cover the cost of the team entry. The amount per child will depend on how many competitors in each team. BIS will pay the competition registration fee.

Payment Discounts

Term payment discount- Payment of the Total Term Invoice Value by the due date will receive a \$25 discount.

Yearly payment discount - If yearly tuition fees are paid in advance the Term Payment Discount x 4 will apply.

The Sibling Discount Change for Existing Families (start year 2021)

This change will be introduced incrementally over 3 years from 2021 to 2023.

ENROLMENT COSTS NOT INCLUDED IN TUITION FEES

Details of all payment agreements and responsibilities of fee payment are detailed in your enrolment contract that you receive if an offer is made to your child to come to BIS.

Waitlist Fee - Names are put on the BIS waiting list on receipt of a completed Waitlist Form and payment of a Waitlist Fee of \$160.00 for each child. This is a non-refundable fee to cover the administration of keeping you in the BIS Community in the years before you start.

Application for Enrolment - Applications for enrolment are considered on receipt of a completed Enrolment Form and payment of an Enrolment Fee of \$660.00. If you are enrolling more than one child in the same term this fee applies once only.

If you decide not to accept the enrolment offer if made, you will forfeit \$260 of the enrolment fee as an administration cost. If your family accepts a place at BIS, \$400 of your enrolment fee will be credited against your Term 1 Invoice the following year. However, this is a non-refundable fee when the student does not continue enrolment for a full 4 terms at BIS.

Bond - A bond must be paid when enrolment is accepted prior to your child starting school. To recover the bond your child must graduate or you must lodge an "Intention to Leave" form by week 5 of the term prior to the one in which you will cease attending. E.g. we are not returning in term 3 therefore we must give notice by week 5 of term 2. Bond amounts vary depending on the number of children you have at the school. They currently are 1st Child is \$2500.00 and 2nd Child is \$1900.00. A bond for the 3rd + child is not requested, however when the first child of a 3 child family leaves, then that 1st child's bond is transferred to the 3rd child.

When the 1st child leaves or graduates and still has siblings enrolled at BIS, the bond value that is refunded is the lesser value of bonds held by the family as a whole.
